

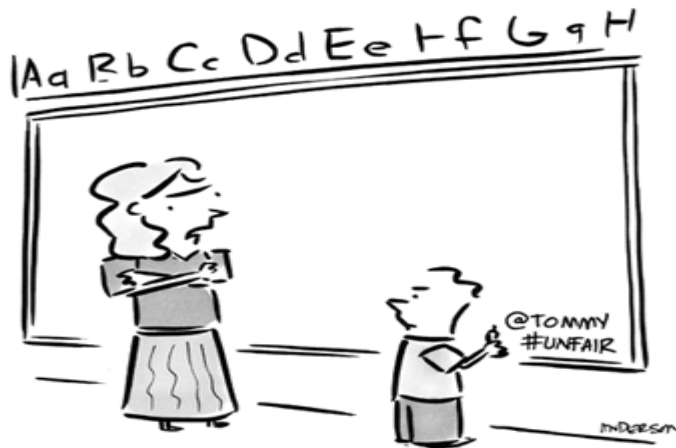

Histograms

A **Histogram** is a bar graph that shows the frequency of data values in intervals of the same size.

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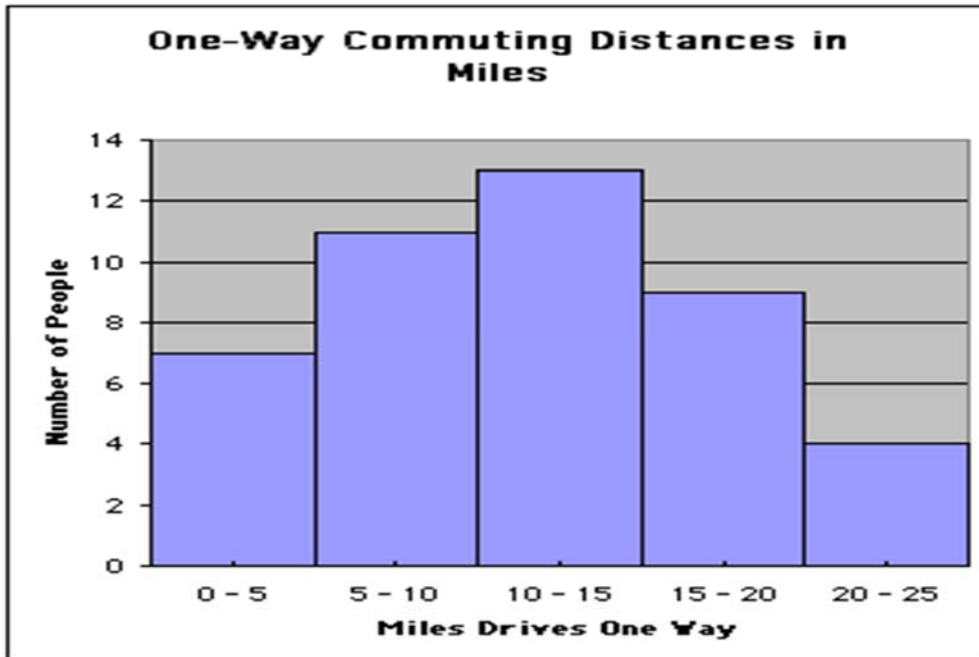
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"Just your name would be fine."

Key to making a Histogram:

- make frequency table with equal intervals
 - title the graph
 - title both axes
- write the intervals on the bottom
 - place bars side by side
- use the vertical scale for frequency
